National target to recycle 50 % of municipal waste

Legislative measures

Naste Act (No. 185/2001 Coll.)

- Prevention community compositing & green compost (§ 10a)
- Biodegradable waste mall composting facilities
 (less than 150 t per year)
 have a simplified regime
 § 33a)

•Decree on the Management of Biodegradable Waste (No. 341/2008 Coll.)

For composting and AD plants

- >The rules of operation
- Evaluation and Control of Outputs
- >Sampling procedures

Recycling of Biowaste

A waste bill (2008, 2009)

- Increase in landfill taxes
- Introduction of fees for other disposal treatments than landfilling
- Obligatory separate collection of municipal wastes glass, plastics, paper, metals, beverage packages (tetrapacks) + biowaste

Exceptions for communities that have introduces home & community composting

has not been accepted

Directive

- A pure transposition nothing on the top of WFD
- No increase in landfill fees
- No fees for other disposal treatment methods
- No obligation for separate collection

EU legal guidelines would help to divert biowaste from landfills and support recycling

New waste legislation

Currently under preparation

- •Separate collection of biowaste
- Increase in landfill taxes
- •Simplified procedure for the treatment of household biowaste

 Better implementation – share responsibility among various stakeholders (state, regions, municipalities)
