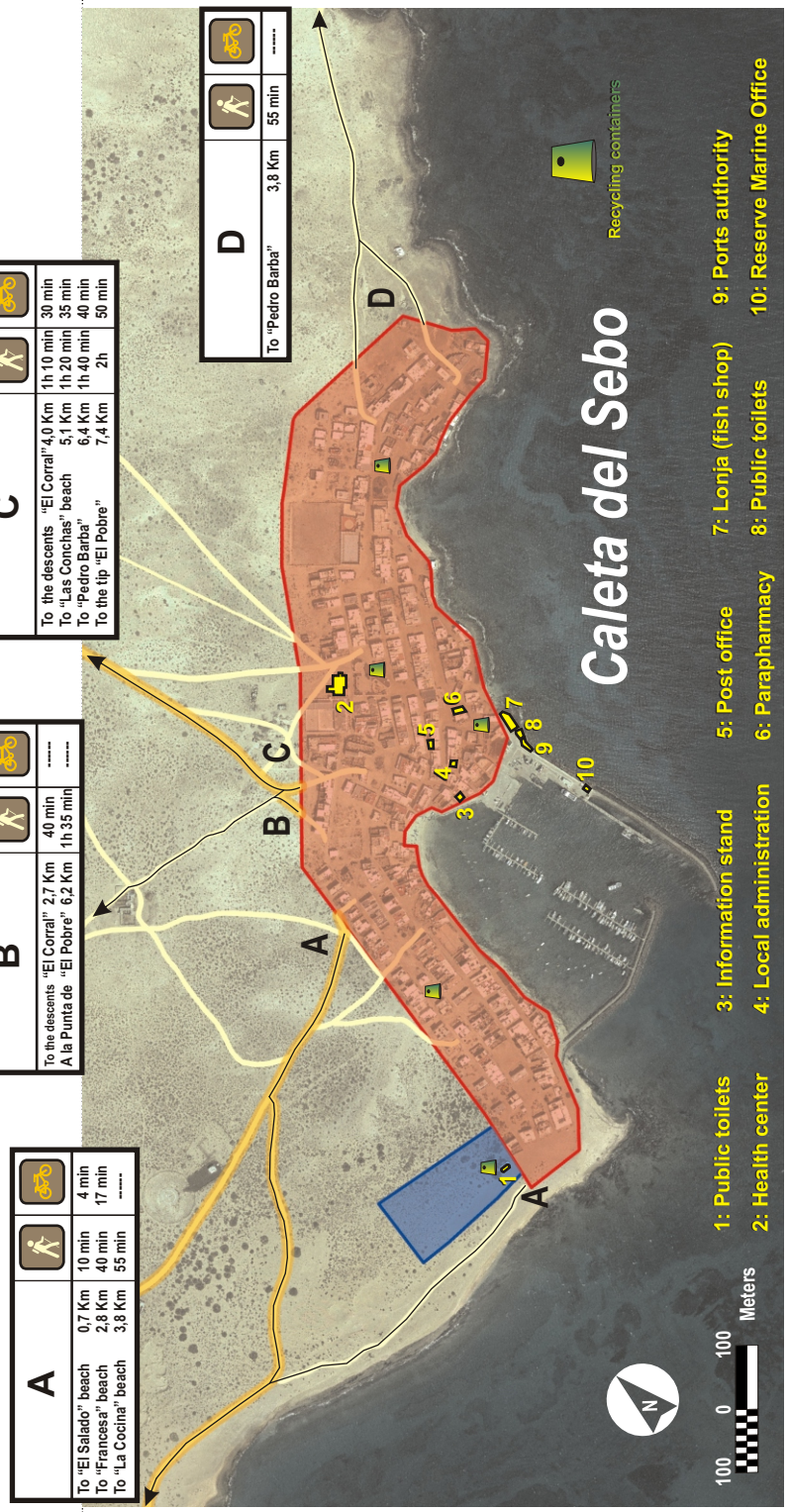

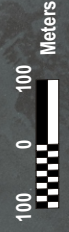

## DURING YOUR STAY...

✍️ Respect the native plants and animals, they are probably unique on earth.

✍️ Walking is a perfect way to explore the island. However avoid walking outside the paths. If you go by bike, keep on the authorized roads.

✍️ There are no guards or rescue staff on the beaches, so be careful, especially on the beaches situated in the northern part of the island.

✍️ If you are camping you must acquire a permission in advance and keep to the designated area. Remember you are in a protected area, so burning wood for fires is not allowed.

✍️ For fishing don't forget your license. Respect the minimum size limit (try not to fish juvenil fish). Remember, it is forbidden to collect any sea food or to practice under - water - fishing.

✍️ Take away your waste. Collecting rubbish on the island produces high costs through increased staff work load.

✍️ You can buy fresh fish from the lonja - which is a first venture point. Buying your fish there helps to support local economy and traditional fishing practises.
